Airport Messe München Shuttle

Autobus Oberbayern's comfortable, air-conditioned coaches run **every 20 minutes**, operating **non-stop between the airport and productronica trade fair**. Each one-way trip takes less than 45 minutes, and your luggage is stowed securely in the large storage compartment.

One-way tickets cost **€ 9.00**, and **return tickets** cost **€ 15.00**.

If you buy your shuttle bus ticket online, you'll avoid having to wait at the ticket desk.

You can reach us from Munich main station in about 20 minutes by public transport. The exhibition grounds are directly connected to the **U2 subway** stops **Messestadt West** and **Messestadt Ost**.

 **By car** Traffic signs throughout the city will show you the way to Messe München and the ICM—

International Congress Center
Munich.

The fairgrounds are located directly on the **A94** motorway. You can reach it via the exits **Feldkirchen-West** (exit no. 6) or **München-Riem** (exit no. 5).

Depending on which navigation system you use, you will find Messe München and the ICM in the categories Exhibition Grounds, Exhibition Centre or under the keyword "Messe".

There are sufficient parking spaces available for exhibitors and visitors on the fairgrounds. Our traffic guidance system will direct you to the appropriate parking spaces at the individual events.
